INGREDIENTS

- 1 package (8 oz) cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 container (12 oz) whipped topping
- 1 package (15.25 oz) chocolate sandwich cookies
- 2 cups milk
- 1 package (3.9 oz) instant chocolate pudding mix
- Gummy worms and candy eggs for decoration

DIRECTIONS

1. In a large mixing bowl, beat the softened cream cheese and powdered sugar until smooth and creamy.
2. Fold in the whipped topping gently until well combined.
3. In another bowl, whisk together the milk and instant chocolate pudding mix until thickened.
4. Combine the pudding mixture with the cream cheese mixture, stirring until fully incorporated.
5. Crush the chocolate sandwich cookies into fine crumbs and set aside about 1 cup for topping.
6. In a large serving dish, layer half of the pudding mixture, followed by half of the cookie crumbs. Repeat the layers.
7. Top with the reserved cookie crumbs and decorate with gummy worms and candy eggs.
8. Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours before serving to allow the flavors to meld.
