

Easy Jello-Covered Frozen Grapes for Summer Snacking

Looking for a snack that's fun, fruity, and guilt-free? These

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INGREDIENTS

1 lb grapes, any kind (green, red, or black)
6 boxes Jello powder, assorted flavors: Raspberry
Berry Blue
Orange
Lime
Lemon
Grape
1 cup water (for dipping)
Toothpicks (for easy coating and minimal mess)

DIRECTIONS

1. ? Step 1: Prep the Grapes: Remove grapes from stems
2. Wash thoroughly in a colander
3. Pat them dry slightly (you still want a bit of moisture to help the Jello stick)
4. ? Step 2: Set Up Your Coating Station: Pour 1 cup of water into a small bowl
5. Place each : Jello flavor into separate shallow dishes or paper plates
6. ? Step 3: Dip and Roll: Stick a toothpick into each grape
7. Dip it quickly into the water, then roll it in your choice of Jello powder
8. Place the coated grape onto a parchment-lined baking sheet
9. Repeat for all grapes, grouping them by color if you like
10. ? Step 4: Freeze: Place the baking sheet in the freezer for at least 1 hour
11. Grapes should be firm and the : Jello coating should have set

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

Use seedless grapes for best results Want tang?

Try granny smith grapes with lemon or lime Jello Store in freezer-safe bags for quick grab-and-go snacks Serve slightly thawed for a softer bite or frozen for a crunchy pop Make it a fun activity by letting kids dip their own grapes
