INGREDIENTS

(Makes 6-8 Shots) IngredientQuantity

DIRECTIONS

1. Instructions
2. Prep the : Glasses:
3. Pour a thin layer of
4. lime juice
5. onto a small, flat plate. Pour the
6. black sugar
7. onto a separate plate. Dip the rim of each shot glass first into the lime juice, then gently press it into the black sugar to create an even, spooky rim.
8. Combine the : Liquids:
9. Fill a cocktail shaker with
10. . Add the vodka, mixed berry juice, lime juice, and grenadine.
11. Shake the : Potion:
12. Secure the lid and
13. shake vigorously
14. for about 15-20 seconds until the shaker is thoroughly chilled. This ensures the liquids are perfectly blended and icy cold.
15. Strain and : Top:
16. Strain the mixture evenly into the prepared shot glasses.
17. Add the : Sparkle:
18. Top each shot with a generous
19. splash of lemon-lime soda
20. for a bubbly, magical fizz.
21. Garnish and : Serve:
22. Garnish each shot with a

23. gummy worm
24. draped over the rim or a single
25. candy eyeball

SWAPS & NOTES

Vodka ¾ cup Use a good quality unflavored vodka, or swap for raspberry vodka for an extra berry kick.

Mixed Berry Juice ¾ cup Look for a blend of blueberry, raspberry, or cranberry.

The darker the juice, the more "potion-like" the color.

Lime Juice 1 oz Freshly squeezed is always best for the brightest flavor.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

The Spooky Vibe: For the ultimate witchy presentation, serve these shots on a tray with dry ice (handle with care and ensure it never touches the drink or is consumed).

The resulting smoky fog is pure Halloween magic.

Pre-Chill Everything: For the coldest, most refreshing shots, put your vodka, berry juice, and even the shot glasses in the freezer or fridge a few hours before you plan to mix.

Scaling Up for a Crowd: To make a full batch of punch (a great idea if you're serving a larger group like when you're making These Sheet Pan Quesadillas or My Favorite Way to Feed a Crowd Fast), multiply the ingredients by 4-5.
